Hi Cheryl,

I will be forwarding you two email threads that show that at the time that I sent out the Facebook flyer for Sexton Show Lambs, I also sent an email to all of our lamb members. Included in that email I noted to them that if they are a breeder or if they know a breeder that would like their information distributed through the office that I would be happy to do so. A parent of our membership asked that I distribute information on Juan and Marlissa of Gonzalez show lambs as well. I do not distribute information without consent of the person in question so I cc'd Marlissa in my response to her buyer and asked if she would like her information distributed. I then talked to Marlissa at the next fairboard meeting and told her about the flyer that was sent out per request by Sexton Show Lambs and offered again to distribute her information. Marlissa conveyed to me at that time that if a first year showman requested information on lamb breeders through the Extension Office that I could give her information privately but that she does not want her personal information distributed in a widespread format.

After receiving additional requests from this buyer I explained to her that I had spoken with Marlissa on how to distribute Gonzalez Show Lamb information. At that time, I also took the time to build a Gonzalez Show Lambs flyer with contact information via Marlissa's Public Club Lamb Page on Facebook (as to not violate her privacy) and sent it to Marlissa and asked her if she would like me to send that out on her behalf. Marlissa did not respond to that email and I did not send the flyer out as I did not have her consent.

Most recently, just this week in fact, I had one of our new lamb members ask if we knew of any lamb breeders. I told her of three lamb breeders that I knew, including Gonzalez Show Lambs and I also attested to her that my own daughters started out in showing lambs under Marlissa and that I felt that she is an awesome starting point for first year lamb showmen as she works hard to build a strong foundation in lamb showmanship, that she is a very hands on breeder and would offer breeder support throughout the year to her buyers and that she is a local breeder. That mom then asked me if I could send her information on how to contact Marlissa. I did send her the information and I followed up by sending Marlissa an email letting her know that I had given her name and contact information to a new lamb member and gave her the names of that member and her mother.

This last email thread I will not send as it has the personal information of a minor included in it and I will not distribute that information. I have cc'd Marlissa in this response to you and I invite you to ask Marlissa personally about the contents of this email.

In case you did not see my response to your first email concerning the SSL flyer that was distributed I have copied that information and am pasting it here. You will note that in that response I do tell you that I do not distribute personal information of any kind without consent.

Hi Cheryl,

I will be forwarding you two email threads that show that at the time that I sent out the Facebook flyer for Sexton Show Lambs, I also sent an email to all of our lamb members. Included in that email I noted to them that if they are a breeder or if they know a breeder that would like their information distributed through the office that I would be happy to do so. A parent of our membership asked that I distribute information on Juan and Marlissa of Gonzalez show lambs as well. I do not distribute information without consent of the person in question so I cc'd Marlissa in my response to her buyer and asked if she would like her information distributed. I then talked to Marlissa at the next fairboard meeting and told her about the flyer that was sent out per request by Sexton Show Lambs and offered again to distribute her information. Marlissa conveyed to me at that time that if a first year showman requested information on lamb breeders through the Extension Office that I could give her information privately but that she does not want her personal information distributed in a widespread format.

After receiving additional requests from this buyer I explained to her that I had spoken with Marlissa on how to distribute Gonzalez Show Lamb information. At that time, I also took the time to build a Gonzalez Show Lambs flyer with contact information via Marlissa's Public Club Lamb Page on Facebook (as to not violate her privacy) and sent it to Marlissa and asked her if she would like me to send that out on her behalf. Marlissa did not respond to that email and I did not send the flyer out as I did not have her consent.

Most recently, just this week in fact, I had one of our new lamb members ask if we knew of any lamb breeders. I told her of three lamb breeders that I knew, including Gonzalez Show Lambs and I also attested to her that my own daughters started out in showing lambs under Marlissa and that I felt that she is an awesome starting point for first year lamb showmen as she works hard to build a strong foundation in lamb showmanship, that she is a very hands on breeder and would offer breeder support throughout the year to her buyers and that she is a local breeder. That mom then asked me if I could send her information on how to contact Marlissa. I did send her the information and I followed up by sending Marlissa an email letting her know that I had given her name and contact information to a new lamb member and gave her the names of that member and her mother.

This last email thread I will not send as it has the personal information of a minor included in it and I will not distribute that information. I have cc'd Marlissa in this response to you and I invite you to ask Marlissa personally about the contents of this email.
