December 13** Final engineering incorporated into final application to be filed by end of month. Both Fremont and Round Mountain support expansion. Mr. Senderhauf reported that Donley active in this decision and Bob has not heard anything negative from CC BOCC. Tom Flower, Bob Senderhauf discussed educating citizens of CC. Said he would be concerned for the CC residents if they didn't have the information they needed to support the expansion. Senderhauf reported he's had more than 20 meetings with people of CC. Motion to file application unanimously approved.

The Sentinel requested the minutes of the Upper Arkansas Water Conservancy District for the last few years to see who from Custer County attended the meetings and whether the "Blue Line" expansion into norther Custer County was discussed. The above chart reflects the attendance. Note: Last week, three of the meeting dates were missing.

Also note that there is a very big map in the conference room that has been there for years with the Blue Line expansion clearly marked.

Other Observations

In the budget narratives from 2016 forward, Blue Line Expansion was called a priority.

Engineer Chris Manera, Water Commissioner Jerry Livengood, Bill Donley and Manager Terry Scanga met at Deweese Reservoir to discuss the blue line location in Custer County at 10:00 A.M. on July 14, 2017.

In the Legal Reports of October 8 and November $1\ 2018$, the filing of the application was anticipated in November or December.

In the independent audit dated December 31, 2017, it was stated, "Although anticipated to file a supplemental augmentation plan to cover the Eastern portion of Fremont County and part of Custer County by 2016, additional engineering on the "Projection Tool" was not completed until late in 2017.
