**CUSTER COUNTY BOARD OF HEALTH VOTES TO STAY THE COURSE  
WITH LIFTED COVID-19 RESTRICTIONS**

WESTCLIFFE, CO, March 10 - The Custer County Board of Health (BOH) met Wednesday and unanimously reaffirmed their decision to lift all State mandated COVID-19 restrictions. Since their initial vote on March 3, 2021, the BOH has been in daily discussions with State officials, medical experts, and legal advisors. The BOH will work alongside the Colorado Department of Health and Environment (CDPHE) in monitoring local health data and managing Custer County's return to normalcy.

The Custer County Health Agency will observe the health of its citizens daily and the BOH will meet as frequently as necessary to keep Custer County on course in reestablishing normalcy. Citizens and businesses are encouraged to continue implementing safety protocols at their own discretion. The Custer County Public Health Agency will actively monitor and publish local COVID-19 statistics and adjust guidelines as warranted.
